



EMERGENCY MEDICINE FACULTY POSITIONS

The Department of Emergency Medicine at UCLA is seeking additional full-time, core faculty members in several key positions, including:

Research, Critical Care, Pediatric EM, and Assistant Program Director

The positions will be based at the David Geffen School of Medicine at UCLA, associated with the Ronald Reagan UCLA Medical Center (RRMC), a state-of-the-art university teaching hospital on the UCLA campus in Westwood. RRMC is a 520 bed, level 1 trauma center, with 50,000 annual ED visits, and is rated as one of the top hospitals in the U.S. All faculty share responsibilities for patient care, and teaching our residents and UCLA medical students.

Our EM residency program was founded in 1978 and is shared between the Westwood campus and Olive View-UCLA Medical Center. We currently have 50 residents in a PGY1-4 format, and offer fellowships in research, ultrasound, administration, and education.

We seek candidates primarily at the Assistant Professor level, and fellowship training is preferred. Candidates must be Emergency Medicine residency trained, ABEM certified, eligible for California medical licensure, and qualified for faculty appointment in the UCLA School of Medicine.
