Why

- Telehealth is poised for massive growth as healthcare strives to connect an expanding pool of complex patients to their health care providers
- Thomas Jefferson University is leading telehealth adoption through the creation of The National Academic Center for Telehealth
- Fellows will be immersed in a diverse educational telehealth environment enabling the development of leadership and entrepreneurial skills, academic training and clinical expertise.

Who

- A board-certified physician who has completed ACGME-accredited residency and is interested in the field of telehealth.

What

- A one-year telehealth leadership fellowship
- The goals for the fellowship are to:
 - graduate physicians with the attitudes, knowledge and abilities needed to operate an independent telehealth program
 - develop physicians both as telehealth researchers and program leaders
- Fair market compensation (\$100,000 annual + full benefits)
- Fellows will be given the flexibility to pursue a certificate or advanced degree

- Applications accepted on a rolling basis (applications now being accepted)
- First fellow starts July 2015
