An opportunity exists for a Board Certified, Emergency Medicine physician with a passion for clinical medicine to serve as Emergency Department Medical Director. The facility is part of the Maricopa Integrated Health Care (MIHS) system which provides care to the underserved population of metro Phoenix, Arizona. It is a 450-bed hospital with a Level 1 Trauma and Burn Center, and is a major affiliate of the University Of Arizona College Of Medicine – Phoenix Campus and hosts 14 residents/year.

Candidates must have an M. D. or D.O. degree, valid Arizona license, and be Board-certified through ABEM or AOBEM. Clinical and academic appointments commensurate with experience.

The medical director provides direction, leadership and day-to-day management of departmental activities for all medical staff personnel, including the residency training program (as applicable). This position supervises and coordinates the clinical operations of the department in accordance with DMG Policies.

This position demonstrates the professional skills and behaviors to promote comprehensive, cost effective and patient focused care for consumers in a diverse healthcare environment; provides leadership within the department for daily operations and demonstrates and promotes alliance with organizational goals and department leadership. This position is responsible for the development and maintenance of the medical component of healthcare delivery including clinical protocols, quality improvement and peer review which meet applicable laws governing licensure and certification.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

- Will implement programs, activities, and services in order to meet the goals and performance expectations of the department;
- Will work with other physician leaders, Medical Staff, and administrative partners to assure a high quality of care.
- Will be responsible for the overall management of clinical affairs for the emergency department.
- Will report to the Department Chair.
- Will work collaboratively with the MIHS manager responsible for the ED to both solve operational problems and to assure a cohesive approach to policy and planning.
- Will collaborate on a regular basis with the medical director counterparts for other departments and specialty services.
- While remaining active as a clinician and participating as a faculty member in the academic affairs and programs of MIHS, the Medical Director will perform the following administrative duties:
 - Develop, implement, and monitor medical protocols for the ED
 - In collaboration with the responsible DMG manager, determine, monitor, and assure the productivity and utilization goals for DMG specialty services.
 - Participate in determining and developing partnerships with other clinical and community based organizations and coalitions, and contribute to representation of DMG within the functioning these partnerships.
 - Analyze medical management data to optimize the performance of the ED

DMG is a not-for-profit faculty practice plan owned and operated by physicians consisting of more than 400+ providers who represent all the major medical and surgical specialties and sub specialties. DMG is the academic faculty practice plan for the University of Arizona College of Medicine (Phoenix) and is affiliated with the area's most comprehensive teaching hospital and medical center, Maricopa Medical Center.
