I am pleased to announce a fellowship opportunity in Pediatric Emergency Ultrasound at New York Methodist Hospital in Brooklyn, NY. We are now accepting applications for:

New York Methodist Hospital is a busy urban trauma center that sees over 100,000 patients per year, with a diverse patient population. There is a separate Pediatric Emergency Department, with an active PEM fellowship, with 2 fellows per year and an average volume of approximately 30,000 pediatric patients per year.

New York Methodist Hospital has a robust Emergency Ultrasound Fellowship program, and is one of the largest in the country. The Division of Emergency Ultrasound is directed under Dr. Gerardo Chiricolo and the Emergency Ultrasound Fellowship is directed by Dr. Andrew Balk. Pediatric Emergency Ultrasound is co-directed by Dr. Stephanie Doniger and Dr. Sharon Yellin. There are currently 5 ultrasound fellows, with one pediatric ultrasound

fellow. There are 14 Emergency Ultrasound Fellowship-trained faculty on staff, including 2 pediatric emergency ultrasound fellowship-trained faculty.

The 1-year Pediatric Emergency Ultrasound Fellowship program is open to those who are board-certified or board-eligible in Pediatric Emergency Medicine. The goal of the fellowship is to train an enthusiastic individual to become an expert in the field of Pediatric Point-of-Care Ultrasound, who ultimately will be able to develop their own ultrasound program. The fellow's time will be divided between clinical duties and dedicated ultrasound time for hands-on scanning shifts, weekly QA sessions, and performing an original ultrasound research project. There will also be opportunities to participate in local, national, and international teaching projects.
