The Department of Emergency Medicine is recruiting for a full-time academic faculty member to serve as ***Pediatric Emergency Medical Director*** at the Assistant or Associate Professor level. Ideal candidates must have a strong passion for developing our new PEM program along with excellent clinical skills and a demonstrated interest in teaching and scholarly activities. With the support and assistance of Department and Hospital leadership, the founding director of the newly created PEM division will lead the development of a robust Pediatric Emergency Department by establishing evidence based clinical protocols, networking with community physicians and hospital committees to promote best practices and to implement the overarching vision for a new PED centered upon excellence. There are a wide variety of opportunities for program development and scholarly productivity in the areas of pediatric trauma, global medicine, health services, quality & safety and medical education. Candidates must be board eligible or certified in Pediatric Emergency Medicine or BC/BE in both Pediatrics and Emergency Medicine.
