## *EMS FELLOWSHIP*

The EMS fellowship with Penn State Hershey Medical Center is designed to immerse the fellow in all aspects related to ground and air EMS medicine. Penn State Hershey Emergency Medicine has direct oversight over Life Lion Critical Care Transport, Life Lion EMS, and several other ground transport services. The unique geography of the region affords experience and training in both rural and urban settings. Three EMS boarded faculty are available to provide mentorship. Experience in medical command, service oversight, field response, EMS research, and the many interactions which occur with the other 120 prehospital personnel dedicated to the provision of EMS care are available to candidates.

The Fellow will have a clinical faculty appointment through Penn State Hershey Emergency Medicine. Applicants must be graduates of an Accredited ACGME Residency Program in Emergency Medicine.

Highlights of the program include:

- Regular staffing of a dedicated EMS Physician Response vehicle
- Critical care transport experience with hospital-owned air/ground critical care assets
- Mass gathering medicine opportunities at Beaver Stadium and Hershey Entertainment Complex
- Participation with the LionREACH mobile disaster training and evaluation center
- Exposure to EMS Special Operations including tactical EMS, urban search and rescue, and hazardous materials response
- Access to the Penn State Hershey Clinical Simulation Center
- Opportunity to earn a Master's degree in Public Health or Homeland Security
