Emergency Medicine Residency Program Director

The Department of Emergency Medicine is seeking candidates for the position of Residency Program Director for our ACGME-accredited, three-year program with 24 fulltime residents. This program director is responsible for the day-to-day administration of the program as well as the development of a vision for the future. Our curriculum focuses on providing a full range of topics and experiences crucial to the development of emergency medicine physicians, as well as cutting edge simulation experiences in our state-of-the art simulation center. Residents spend the majority of their clinical time at Penn State Hershey Medical Center. In addition, our residents rotate at Pinnacle Health System's Harrisburg Hospital.

Penn State Hershey Medical Center is a large academic teaching hospital, a designated Level I trauma center for both adult and pediatric patients and is the only Level I pediatric trauma center just 90 minutes from Philadelphia and Baltimore in beautiful Hershey, PA. Hershey provides a family-friendly environment with top-rated schools and superb outdoor recreation.

Our growing University Emergency Department (ED) cares for upwards of 70,000 patients annually at a comprehensive academic health center. Twenty-five board-certified faculty provide daily ED staffing of 72 hours of physician coverage with 36 hours of physician assistant and nurse practitioner support. Our affiliated community ED cares for 24,000 patients annually and has 24 hours of physician and 16 hours of physician assistant coverage. Our Level I Adult and Pediatric Trauma Center, Cancer Center and brand new Children's Hospital assure that we continue to be the primary referral hospital for a 7,000 square-mile area. Our 'Life Lion' Flight and Ground EMS Division, outstanding clinical informatics and extramurally funded research programs add to the academic opportunities.

Applicants must have educational leadership experience, three years experience as a core faculty member at an ACGME-approved Emergency Medicine Residency Program, and be board certified by ABEM. Candidates must have strong interpersonal skills and be able to work collaboratively within diverse academic and clinical environments. Faculty appointment and salary will be commensurate with qualifications.
