



The University of Chicago's Department of Pediatrics, Section of Emergency Medicine, seeks faculty in the section of Pediatric Emergency Medicine. The successful applicants will have an MD or MD/PhD and hold or be eligible for licensure in the State of Illinois. Applicants who are BC/BE in Pediatric Emergency Medicine or who have completed combined Pediatrics/Emergency Medicine training are preferred. Duties include patient care, teaching of medical students, pediatric and emergency medicine housestaff and pediatric emergency medicine fellows.

The Pediatric Emergency Department, the only Level I Pediatric Trauma Center on the south side of Chicago, treats more than 35,000 patients a year. It is a newly renovated free-standing state-of-the-art facility with 22 general exam rooms, two procedure rooms, two triage rooms and two trauma/resuscitation rooms. In addition to clinical care, the pediatric emergency department is a training site for pediatric and emergency medicine residents from four residency training programs and home to a thriving ACGME accredited pediatric emergency medicine fellowship.

Prior to the start of employment applicants must 1) have a MD, MD/PhD or equivalent, 2) hold or be eligible for medical licensure in the State of Illinois, and 3) be able to demonstrate excellent clinical and medical education teaching skills. Applicants who are BC/BE in Pediatric Emergency Medicine or who have completed combined Pediatrics/Emergency Medicine training are preferred. Rank and salary will be determined by qualifications and experience. The University of Chicago offers an excellent benefits package.
