



Clinical Research Faculty – Open Rank

The University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston is seeking an MD to join our faculty, with a rank commensurate with experience in the Department of Emergency Medicine. The candidate will maintain clinical shifts, but will have a primary emphasis on growing a funded research program. It is our vision that this individual will bring in a significant amount of clinical translational research funding in emergency medicine (emphasis in neurological, cardiovascular, trauma, or other topical research area in EM). Located in the Texas Medical Center, the largest medical center in the world, the Department has a fully accredited three-year residency training program with 53 residents, serves 4 hospitals (including a Level 1 trauma center), and approximately 140,000 patients annually. The Department works closely with the renowned UT stroke and cardiovascular programs, and directs a state-of-the-art simulation center. The department has a large research infrastructure that includes a Research Director, full time grants/contract specialists, statistician, research associates, and administrative support.

The candidate must possess the qualifications sufficient for appointment to the appropriate rank. The applicant should have a proven track record of publications in high-impact clinical EM journals, as well as significant funding through research grant awards as principal investigator. The successful candidate shall receive a very competitive remuneration package including substantial protected time to develop the research interests of the Department's mission and to promote these interests nationally and internationally.
