The TTUHSC El Paso Department of Emergency Medicine staffs the emergency room of University Medical Center of El Paso, a Level I Trauma Center with approximately 60,000 visits annually.

Major Essential Functions:

- Serves as assistant director of EMS for the Division of Emergency Medical Services in the department.
- Develops and implements EMS consult service for inpatient and outpatient settings.
- Assists with the development of EMS curricula for new fellowship program.
- Supervises medical EMS fellows, residents and students.
- Provides performance evaluation, skill testing, and mentoring of residents, fellows and medical students.
- Provides patient care in the emergency department.
- Participates in residents and faculty recruitment.
- Serves as medical control physician for El Paso EMS while on duty in the emergency department.
- Assists department chair with implementation of departmental policies and monitoring staffing effectiveness.
- Participates in national societies, such as ACEP, SAEM, ACMT and AACT.
- Participates in medical research projects related to emergency medicine.
- Participates in medical school and hospital committees.
- Assists with development and implementation of special departmental projects, conference presentations to residents, students, nurses and EMTs.
- Participates in chart audits and other clinical performance improvement efforts. Attends and participates in morbidity-mortality conference and journal clubs. • Demonstrates professionalism in accordance with the Paul L.
