

## RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP in EMERGENCY MEDICINE

The University of Florida Department of Emergency Medicine - Jacksonville is seeking a motivated candidate for our Emergency Medicine Research Fellowship. Our fellowship provides residency and fellowship-trained clinicians with the skills required to become successful physician-scientists who can design and implement high quality research studies that lead to independent research careers. The fellowship contains a core curriculum in addition to electives, which may be of one or two year duration depending upon the individual candidate's interests and goals. We offer a hands-on practical research experience with complementary didactics covering epidemiology and study design, biostatistics and data science, grant and manuscript writing, and research ethics. Our research fellows have the opportunity to work within a division that houses multiple NIH-funded and industry-funded principal investigators. Fellows receive appointment with the University of Florida, College of Medicine as a Post-Doctoral Associate.

The research fellowship is located within the Division of Research in the Department of Emergency Medicine, and offers a competitive salary and benefits package. The research fellow will work with a fellowship director, Dr. Jennifer Fishe or Dr. Sophia Sheikh, and a primary mentor selected based on the fellow's research interests. Expert mentors are available in the areas of artificial intelligence / machine learning, asthma / respiratory distress, emergency medical services, pain management, and precision emergency medicine. In addition, Division of Research faculty are actively involved in over thirty studies including clinical trials, translational research and epidemiologic studies, has a staff of research coordinators offering 7-day per week emergency department coverage, and houses its own Emergency Medicine Research Laboratory.

Clinical work covers our two main hospitals, UF Health Jacksonville Downtown (including its Pediatric Emergency Department) and UF Health North, as well as three freestanding emergency departments and an Urgent Care Facility at UF Wildlight. Those clinical sites offer a diverse patient population and wide range of pathologies as well as ideal settings for both clinical practice and research. The Downtown hospital is an ACS accredited Level 1 trauma center. The city of Jacksonville is a rapidly growing city, with a warm climate and southern hospitality complimenting a wealth of cultural events and outdoor activities, miles of beaches, low cost-of-living, no state income tax, a major airport, and is a short drive to Atlanta, Savannah, Orlando, and Charleston.
